

Our special speaker, Maryland Delegate Anne Kaiser, will discuss: "16

Years of Success on LGBTQ+ Rights in Annapolis—What We Have Accomplished, and the Challenges Ahead."

Anne Kaiser is in her sixth 4-year term as a delegate, representing the 14th District in Montgomery County, and is a lifelong member of Tikvat Israel in Rockville.

In June 2008, she spoke at our annual service on "Civil Marriage Is a Civil Right: A Gay Jewish View in Annapolis." She has been an important leader in securing the progress made in Maryland since that time.

She is a member of the Health and Government Operations Committee and House Chair of the Joint Committee on Cybersecurity, Information Technology and Biotechnology. Her previous service includes time as Chair of the powerful House Ways & Means Committee and of the Montgomery County Delegation, the largest in the state of Maryland.

Anne grew up in Montgomery County and graduated from Rockville High School, before earning her bachelor's degree from the University of Chicago, as well as two master's degrees from the University of Michigan.

A clinical professor at the University of Maryland, College Park, she is Associate Director of the Institute for Public Leadership at the School of Public Policy and teaches undergraduate policy courses.

Anne lives with her wife, Nancy, and their daughter, Allison Joan "AJ," in the Calverton neighborhood of Silver Spring.
