

RESOLUTION TO INSTITUTE SECURITY FEE TO ALL MEMBER HOUSEHOLDS

In response to events at Tree of Life Synagogue in Pittsburgh and the Chabad Synagogue in Poway, a task force was set up to review our police presence at Religious Services. The funding to provide police patrols for the next fiscal year is \$15,000, or approximately \$36/household.

At the Board of Trustees meeting on March 21, 2019, the Board voted to ask the Temple Emanuel membership, at the Annual Meeting on May 19, 2019, to approve assessing a \$36 security fee per household, principally designated to provide police coverage at all religious services.

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2019, the Congregation of Temple Emanuel, in accordance with its bylaws, and at which a quorum of the congregation were present, authorized an assessment of \$36/household as a security fee, designated to provide police coverage at all religious services.
