Global Mitzvah Team – Supports charitable projects in developing countries

EDUCATION

Adult Education - Plans educational opportunities for adults

Torah Study (Saturdays at 9:00am) - Minyan and Torah Study group where all are welcome to join discussions of the weekly Torah portion and other books comprising the Hebrew Bible

Adult B'Nei Mitzvah – A two-year program of learning and Jewish engagement for adults, culminating in a B'Nei Mitzvah ceremony
